**Audio cassette is an analog magnetic tape recording format for audio recording and playback that was developed by Philips.**



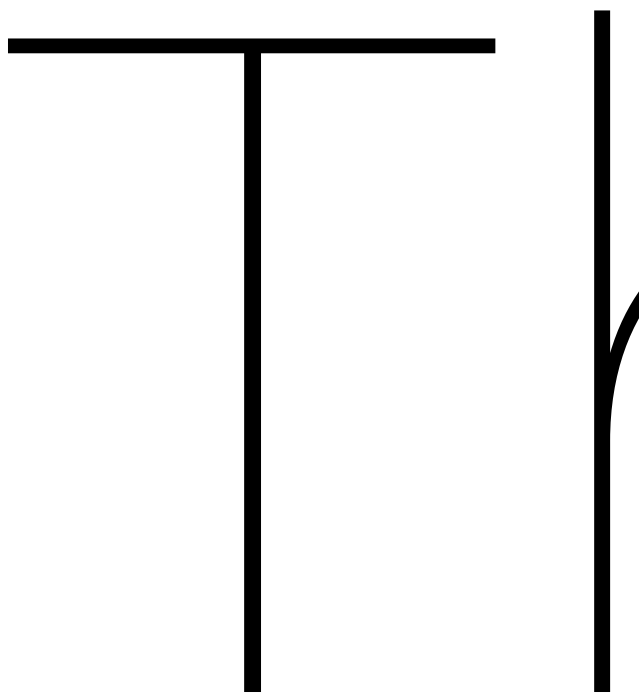
VHS, officially called the Video Home System, is a standard for consumer-level analog video recording on tape cassettes. From the 1950s, magnetic tape video recording became true major contributor to the television industry, via the first commercialized video tape recorders. At that time, the expensive devices were used only in professional environments such as television studios and medical imaging.

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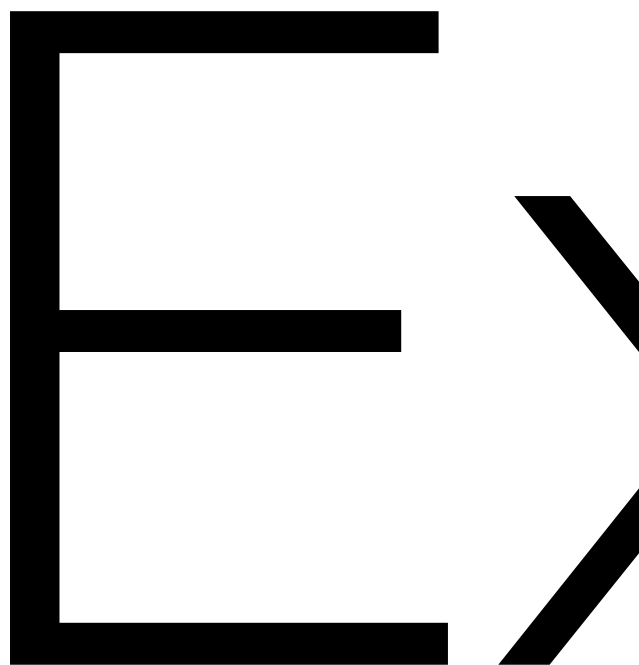
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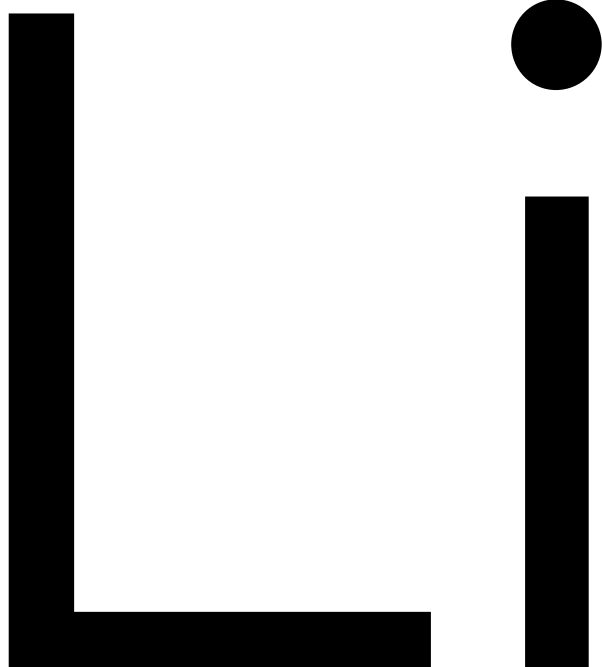
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***The first Macintosh, unveiled in 1984, was the first successful personal computer with a user friendly graphical user interface. The Macintosh was pivotal in starting the desktop publishing revolution. It had an all in one design, and was described as a revolution by the New York Times. The Macintosh name was conceived in 1979, when Apple employee Jef Raskin envisioned an easy to use, low cost computer for the average consumer, and wanted to name the computer after his favorite type of apple, the McIntosh. In 1983, Apple licensed the rights to the Macintosh name from audio equipment manufacturer, and in 1986, bought the trademark***

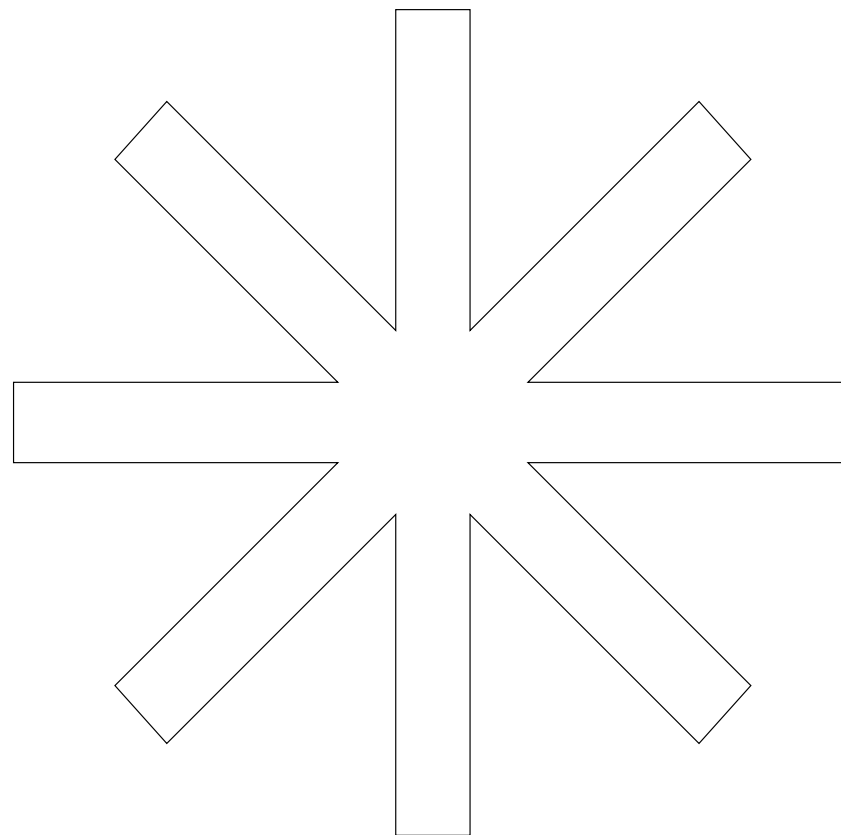
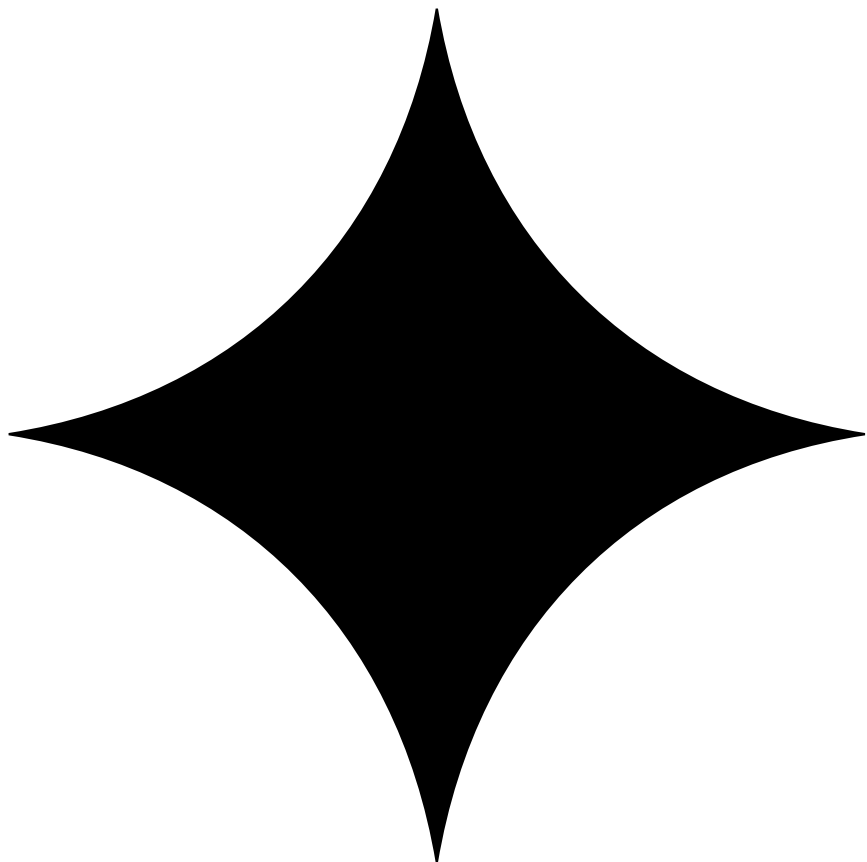
