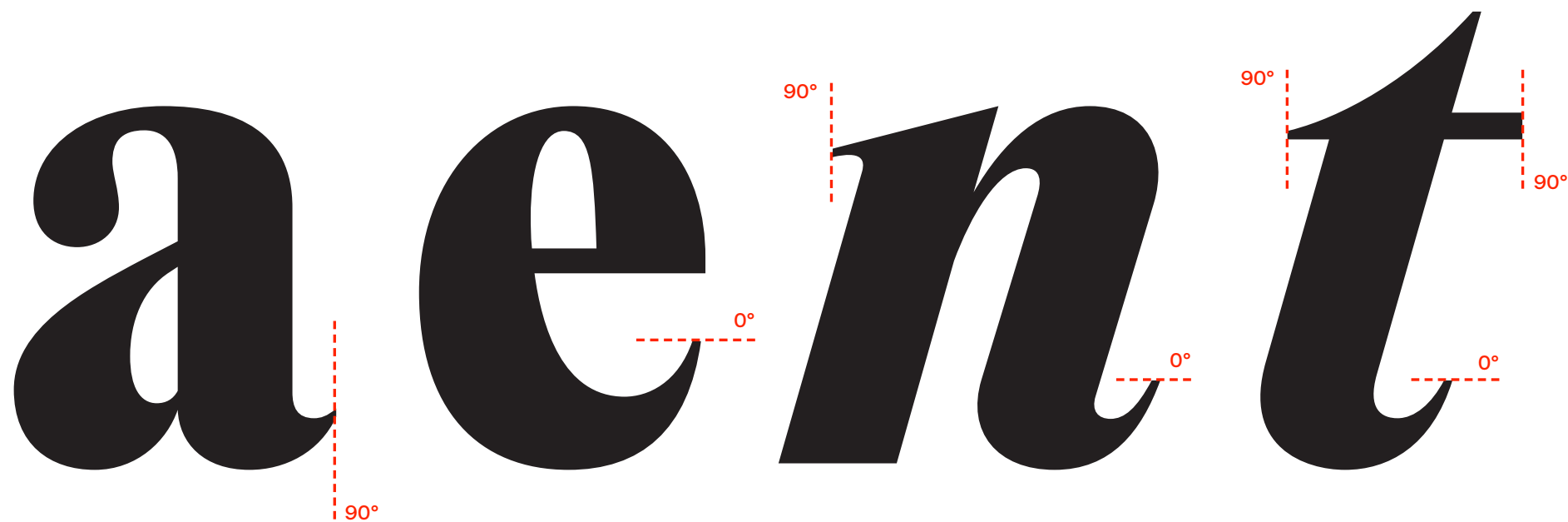

About the font

Eternia draws from the visual landscape of technology magazines, press supplements, and advertising typography of the nineteen-seventies and eighties. Tall proportions and a semi-condensed fit give it a compact vertical presence, while controlled contrast and slightly tight spacing recreate the density and texture of that era's headlines. The result feels familiar without being nostalgic, something that could have existed decades ago and still reads as current.

The license allows converting or outlining the fonts to create a static logo design for branding purposes. Licenses are based on the total number of employees of the company using the logo. Corporate license A perpetual combination of all our licenses: Desktop, Webfont, Digital Ads, App-Epub and Logotype.
